Supplies:

- **Stamps:** Sealed with Love (142815)
- **Paper :**
 - 142733 Sending Love Designer Series Paper Stack (1-1/4" x 5" – 2 pieces)
 - 102482 Real Red cardstock (2-1/4" x 2-1/4, 1-1/2" x 1-1/2")
 - 100730 Whisper White cardstock (2-1/2" x 2-1/2", 3/4" x 2", 2" x 2")
 - 135314 Silver Glimmer Paper (1-3/4" x 1-3/4")
- **Ink :** 126949 Real Red, 101731 Whisper White
- **Other :** 141699 Clear Tiny Treat Boxes, 142752 Love Notes Framelits, 145372 Stitched Shapes Framelits, 141705 Layering Circles Framelits, 141707 Sweet & Sassy Framelits, 142757 Succulent Framelits, 142735 Sending Love Embellishments, 142737 Sending Love Ribbon Combo Pack, 119246 Rhinestone Basic Jewels, 129026 Fast Fuse Adhesive, 104430 Stampin' Dimensionals, 103683 Mini Glue Dots

Instructions:

1. Adhere 2 pieces of dsp together on ends using Fast Fuse to make belly band around box. Make sure the seams are on the top and bottom of the box so they won't be seen.
2. Cut out 2" scalloped circle from white cs using Layering Circles framelits. Cut out 2nd smallest stitched circle from red cs using Stitched Shapes Framelits. Adhere red circle to white scalloped circle.
3. Stamp largest heart image in Real Red ink on white cs and cut out with coordinating framelit from Love Notes framelits set. Cut out red striped heart from red cs using framelits and 1-1/2" heart from silver glimmer paper using Sweet & Sassy framelits.
4. Stamp sentiment in Real Red ink on white cs and cut out using little banner from Succulent Framelits.
5. Push small scalloped wooden heart into white ink pad to coat and allow to dry or heat set.
6. Adhere circle to center of belly band on top of box using dimensionals.
7. Adhere red heart to silver heart using glue dots. Adhere all hearts to circles as shown using glue dots.
8. Adhere banner to circle using glue dots and bend slightly upward in center to give dimension.
9. Tie a piece of the red 1/8" ribbon into a box and adhere to circle with glue dots. Adhere a medium rhinestone to right side of stamped heart.
